**NRV Train Show** – Volunteers are needed to staff the Division's display at the annual Neuse River Valley (NRV) Train Show on **November 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>** at the State Fairgrounds in Raleigh, NC. We plan to have several tables for display and sale of donated items, plus space for the HO scale raffle layout. **EduTRAIN** - The NMRA is working on an education and training initiative. The effort is being spearheaded by a team lead by Michiana Division Superintendent Jim Six and Robert Blake. The Michiana Division will conduct a one day overview of EduTRAIN on November 16, 2013 in Middlebury, Indiana. There is space for up to 24 attendees. The course is a "train the trainer" session specifically intended to train those people in each region or division who have responsibility for education and training so they can carry the program back to their home region or division and encourage courses to be developed using the EduTRAIN methodology. EduTRAIN course curriculum will likely become a recommended practice that will be available to Regions and Divisions to both increase the number of courses available and raise the overall quality of education provided through the NMRA.
