Due to a very heavy increase in motor vehicle traffic our grade crossing over Liberty Avenue in Union, N. J., is now a very dangerous proposition and during the past several weeks we have received numerous complaints in regard to the very careless manner in which we operate over it.

Effective at once all trains operating northbound will come to a stop and crossing flagged before passing over it.

Operating southbound visibility is not impaired in any way so it will not be necessary to stop and flag, however, the speed over this crossing is restricted to five miles per hour.
